I read an article about masons that were inventors, so I want to share with you their names and what they invent-

# King Camp Gillette (1855-1932)

It can reasonably claimed that the American innovator King Gillette changed the world when he launched the cheap, Disposable safety razor to a grateful public in 1901.

# Samuel Colt (1814-1862

The American industrial and inventor Samual Colt is best known for popularizing the revolver the eventually led to the Colt Single Action Army revolver, otherwise known as the Colt 45. He applied for his first patent at the age of 18, and his dream of perfecting the impossible gun never faded.

# Richard Gatling (1818-1903)

American inventor, builder of firearms. Best known as the constructor of the rapid-fire hand cranked gun with a rotating Beam barrel(patented in 1862) which is the first successful version of a machine gun, and called, from his name, the Gatling's gun.

# Edward Jenner (1749-1823)

English doctor, discoverer of the smallpox vaccine. This discovery paved the way to the widespread use of preventive Vaccination in counteracting many serious diseases.

# Sir Alexander Flemming (1881-1955)

While organizing and removing bacterial cultures from their vessels, Flemming noticed blue mold growing on one of the Colonies which seemed to be killing harmful bacteria. After many experiments, he discovered penicillin G, which is strongly bactericidal and gentle to humans. He received a Nobel Prize in medicine in 1945.

# **Dr. Edward Jenner** (1749-1823)

The discovery of the smallpox vaccine by Dr. Edward Jenner is said to have saved more lives than any work done by other men. His findings indicated that cowpox, which was commonly found on milkmaids, could be used to counter-attack the effects of smallpox. Edwards was an active Freemason. He served as a master of the Royal Lodge of Faith and Friendship, No 270 in Berkley, Gloucestershire, in 1812.

# Harland David Sanders (1890-1980)

The founder of Kentucky Fried Chicken famously known as KFC developed a 'secret recipe' of cooking fried chicken. Sanders went ahead to patent the method of preparing chicken in a pressure fryer after recognizing the potential of his Recipe holds.

# James Watt (1736-1819)

A Scottish inventor developed the concept of horsepower (Continued on page 5) Page 2

used to measure the rate of work. It is often applied when determining the output of engines or motors in general. Apart from that, SI Symbol Watt used to quantify the rate of 1 Joule per second when measuring the rate at which energy is transferred was named after him. James was an active Freemason. He was initiated into the brotherhood in his mid-twenties at the Glasgow Royal Arch No. 77.
