# PEACE & HARMONY

**T**he Grand Master's vision for the 2025-2026 Masonic term, themed "Peace and Harmony," is a call to action for us to improve ourselves, our lodges, and our communities by living the principles of Brotherly Love, Relief, and Truth, and by being a force for good in the world.



## Grand Master Chan's Pin

- Perimeter Pattern: The intricate pattern encircling the pin symbolizes infinity, eternity, unity and the Interconnectedness of all things—including the winding paths of life.
- Red: In Chinese culture, red represents good fortune, happiness, and energy.



- Gold: Gold signifies wealth, prosperity, and success.
- Shield: The black Templar-style shield is a tribute to my time in DeMolay. That experience helped shape who I am today. It serves as a personal reminder to remain faithful to the teachings and vows I embraced as both a DeMolay and a Mason.
- Chinese Character: At the center is the Chinese character for Harmony—a guiding principle and the theme for the coming year.
- Square and Compass: Depicted in the Entered Apprentice configuration, the Square and Compass represents the universal journey of Masonry.
- This pin is intentionally designed to be inclusive, so that all Masons— regardless of degree—may wear it with pride.
